How it works

A partnership press—not a vanity press!

In traditional publishing practice, the publisher pays for production of the book. The publisher owns the books that are printed and sells them, assuming the risk and possible benefits of those sales. When the costs of production are recovered, the author receives a royalty. QuakerPress of FGC has long experience working in this model.

But in the rapidly-changing world of publishing, “traditional” is only part of the story. More and more books are being published by the authors themselves.

QuakerBridge Media is a middle way. We offer the professionalism, the reputation, and the selectivity of a known publisher in an arrangement where the costs of production are assumed by the author (or a funder). The author/funder then owns the books that are printed, assuming the financial risks and benefits of selling them. When the costs of production are recovered, FGC receives a portion of revenues from subsequent sales.

- Friends General Conference puts our name behind QuakerBridge Media titles. We select only those manuscripts that meet the content requirements and standards of professionalism we require for QuakerPress (our traditional imprint).
