The clever use of intertitles — such as "18 inches of personal space" or "Once I knew a happy man. There has been a great response to the new Library system. It will take some getting used to and there are still things to be worked out about we now have a great new resource.

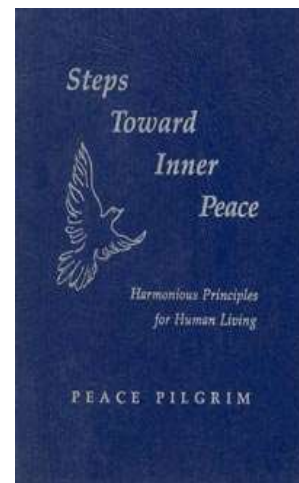
The Secretary is available to assist with the use of the new software Tuesdays and Thursday 9-3

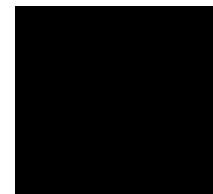
