



DIRECTIONS TO DANCING BEAR FARM

From Interstate 80:

Take Hwy 15 South (exit 210). Turn right (east on Col. John Kelly Road (approx 3.5 miles from I80). John Kelly Road is not an exit. It is simply a right hand turn. It is the next right after the exit for Hwy 642 to Milton. You may notice Byerly's Meat Market on your right just as you need to make the turn. Or you may notice CVC Contractors just after you've missed the turn ☺ In either event, once you get on John Kelly Road, you can follow the directions below...

Hwy 15 – South from I-80 or North from Lewisburg:

Turn West on Col. John Kelly Road at Byerly's Meat Market (from the south you'll see a sign "Penitentiary Truck Entrance"). If coming from I-80 this will be a right turn, if coming from Lewisburg this will be a left turn. After about 2.5 miles you will pass the back entrance to the penitentiary on your left. Continue 0.8 miles to gravel lane on your right. Look for a small bridge, then a group of houses on your right. The lane is between the third and fourth house. The gravel lane is named "Dancing Bear Lane" and is very well marked by a reflective brown & white street sign.

---- OR ----

Hwy 192 West from Lewisburg:

Turn right on Strawbridge Road. Follow Strawbridge all the way to its end at Col. John Kelly Road. Immediately in front of you is a big red dairy barn. Turn right on Col. John Kelly Road. On your left after the dairy will be an open field, a driveway, more open field, a small parking lot in front of a welding shop, a house next to the welding shop, a large garden, and the three houses in a row. Turn left on the little gravel lane (Dancing Bear Lane) between the second and third houses.

----- IN EITHER CASE -----

Dancing Bear Lane looks like a driveway! Just look for the road sign. Turn onto the gravel lane and follow it all the way to the end (about 1/4 mile) over the creek and past a large house on your left. We are at the end of the road. Keep driving until you can go no farther. You are now looking at the Dancing Bear Barn. Overnight guests may park directly in front of the Farmhouse. Event guests may park anywhere in the gravel area in front of the barn! We're looking forward to welcoming you to this wonderful place ☺
