


How to Request Access to the Madison Quaker Cloud


Go to the Meeting website: www.madisonfriends.org

With an account on the Quaker Cloud you can:

- Subscribe to an eNewsletter from FGC or Quakerbooks.
- Update or unsubscribe from these email lists.
- Propose a workshop for the FGC Gathering (during the workshop proposal window, often August - September).

If your meeting uses the Quaker Cloud for your website, you can:

- Access content that is private and accessible only to members/attenders of your meeting.
- Access your meeting's member/attender directory.
- Search your meetings private minutes.

If you already receive the FGC eNewsletter, Book Musings, Gathering emails you already have an account.
