

# Directions to the Durham Friends Meeting

## 404 Alexander Avenue, Durham NC 27705

Durham Friends Meeting is located on the west side of Durham on Alexander Avenue between Erwin Road and Campus Drive near Duke University and the Duke Hospitals. The small brick meetinghouse fronting on Alexander Avenue, labeled Building "B" with a sign on the front door, is the historic or original home of Durham Friends. It is now used for Quaker youth education and meetings. The present meetinghouse can be reached by walking around the left end of the historic meetinghouse, through the gate and following the path across the playground to the stairs leading to the meetinghouse porch. It may also be reached through another gate from the back of the parking lot shared with the Ronald McDonald House.

The Durham Friends Meeting is located near the Durham Freeway, NC 147. Depart the Durham Freeway at Exit 14 for Swift Avenue. Turn southward onto Swift Avenue and proceed to the blinking red light at the bottom of the hill. Turn right onto Campus Drive and take the second right onto Alexander Avenue. The meetinghouse is on the left immediately after the Ronald McDonald House.
