Greetings to you in Faith, Hope and Love:

We write to you in sorrow and hope.

We recall with sorrow that it was here in Philadelphia that Richard Allen and other original leaders of the African Methodist Episcopal Church were excluded from their place of worship. We rejoice in hope at the way the AME Church community has turned exclusion into a faith-life of creative self-determination.

We recall with sorrow the long centuries in which African-American churches have been targeted for damage and death. We long in hope for the day when the Peaceable Kingdom that Isaiah foresaw and Jesus proclaimed will be fully present.

We sorrow now for the loss at Mother Emanuel AME Church in Charleston of faithful leaders and servants of God's love. We are filled by hope as we witness the Divinely inspired love your community has shared not only to the bereaved but even to the man who has confessed to this terrible crime.

We sorrow that racism and hate still exist and are expressed in such terrible acts. We sorrow that our society continues to make weapons too readily available. We recall with hope the many bonds the Religious Society of Friends, Friends General Conference and the African Methodist Episcopal Church have formed in the World Council of Churches and in more local ecumenical and interfaith bodies. Together we will continue to work for a better society, for the realization of the beloved community.

In 1647, one of our founders, George Fox, wrote in his spiritual Journal: "I saw...that there was an ocean of darkness and death; but an infinite ocean of Light and Love...flowed over the ocean of darkness." Our hearts are with you, hoping that by your deep and true knowledge of that infinite ocean of Light and Love you are comforted and strengthened in this sad time.
