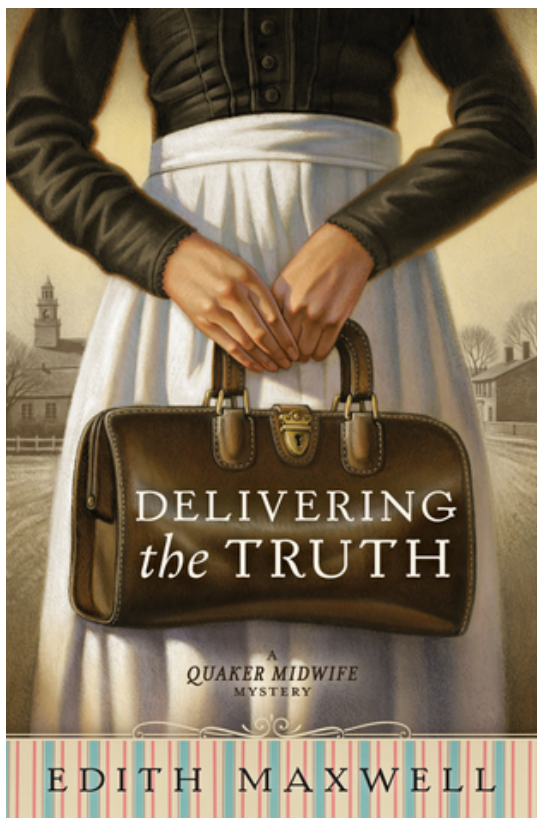
dedication to the ministry of the word and know that many Friends will miss them, as will we.

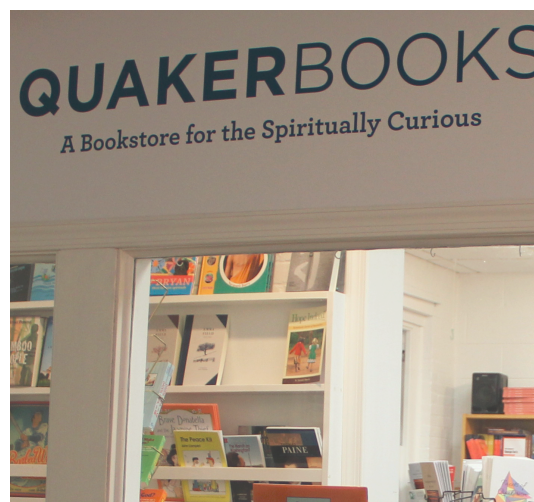

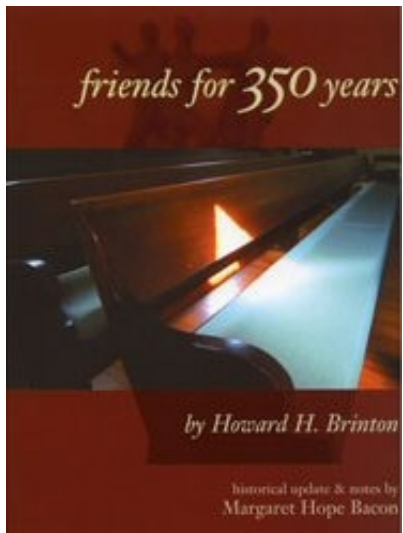
