Guarding Your Dorm Key:

- **Replacement keys or meal cards if lost:** Ottawa West Residence Hall Desk
- Key replacements are **\$125.00**
- Swipe card replacements are \$10.00
- Both fees due to the University at replacement time.
- Keys, swipe cards, and card holders are to be returned to UT at check out.
- FGC Will be charging for keys not returned at check out.

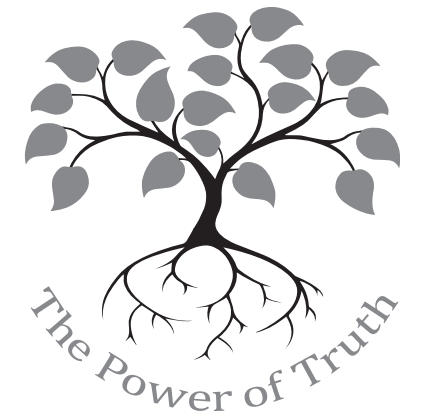

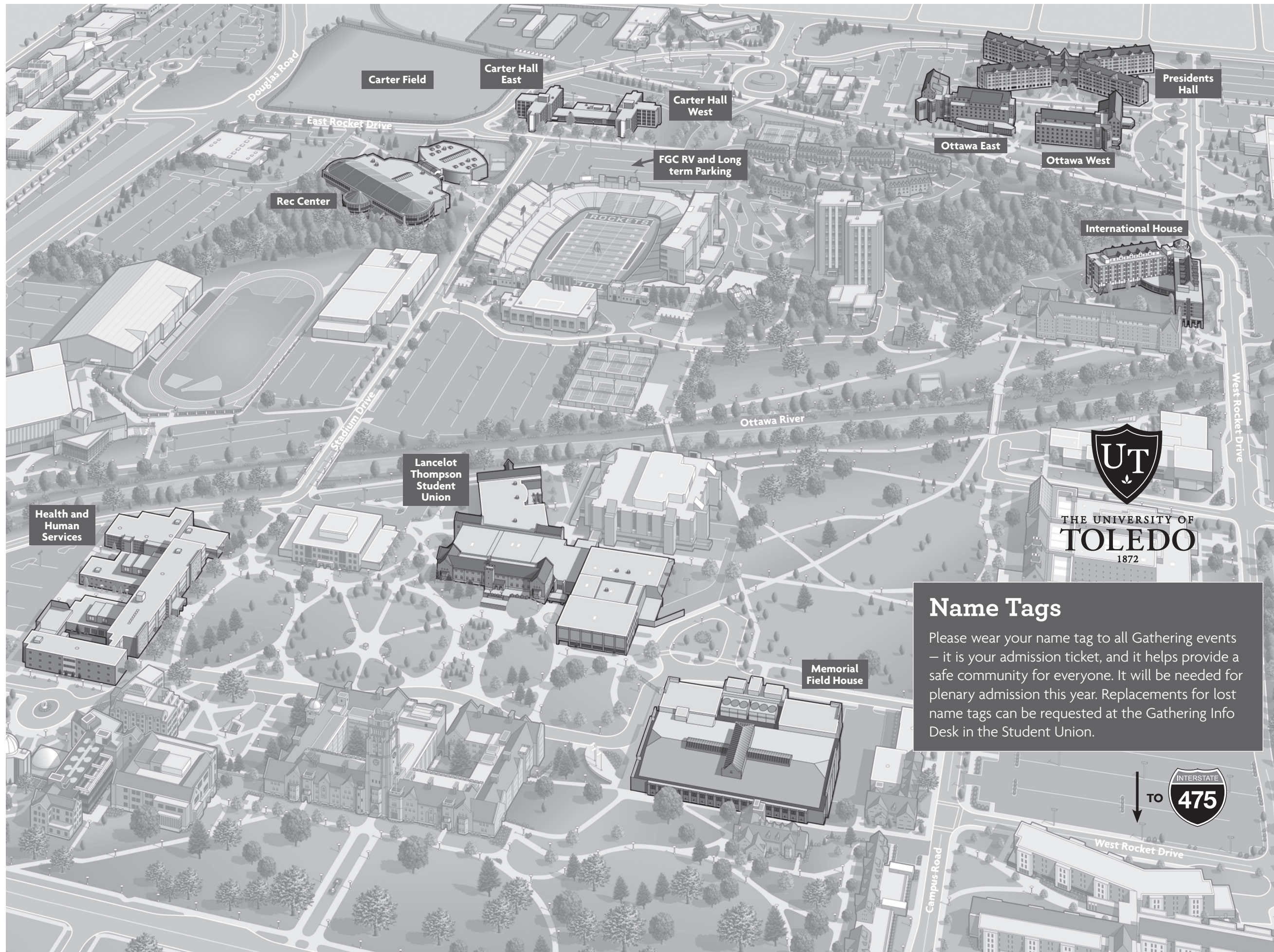
